The Reaction	What it reveals	Where Christians see it today	Key Scriptures (New Testament)
<b>Jealousy</b>	Threatened influence, insecurity, fear of losing control.  Someone feels their influence, status, or control is threatened.	Promotions, leadership roles, visibility, favor, gifting.	Acts 17, Acts 13, Acts 5, and even in the Gospels
<b>Insecurity</b>	Fragile identity, fear of being overshadowed.	Micromanagement, territorial behavior, defensiveness.	Nazareth (Luke 4), religious leaders in Acts 4–5
<b>Offense</b>	People prefer the familiar version of you.  Resistance to truth, discomfort with growth or change.	“Who do you think you are?” energy.  People minimizing your position, calling or credentials.	Nazareth (Luke 4) is the clearest example.
<b>Anger/ Rage</b>	A spiritual stronghold is being threatened.	Sudden hostility, disproportionate reactions, emotional volatility.	Nazareth mob (Luke 4), Thessalonica riot (Acts 17), Ephesus riot (Acts 19)
<b>Control</b>	People fear losing power or influence.	Gatekeeping, silencing, withholding information, territorial behavior.	Religious leaders in Acts 3–4 and Acts 5 show this clearly. Also, sorcerers in Acts 8 and 13.
<b>Fear</b>	People prefer predictable bondage over unpredictable freedom.	Avoidance, withdrawal (shutting down conversations), resistance to change.	Gerasene region begging Jesus to leave (Mark 5).
